

Under 18's

Young people aged 14-15 can go into licensed venues but can't buy or drink alcohol. However, some licensed premises do not allow people under the age of 21 due to their licensing conditions.

Under 18 nights (aged between 13 to 17 years old) in Central Milton Keynes are a common occurrence - as are the police officers who routinely patrol them, scanning the crowds for anyone looking to spoil the teenagers' alcohol-free fun.

In these venues no alcohol dispensers are on show in the club.

New technology trialled by the Police and licensing is now used to test soft drinks for alcohol. No admittance is given to anyone under the influence of Alcohol and the Police contact the parent/guardian who are requested to collect their child. If no contact is made they are removed to the police station.
